CAMP KRISLUND: In 1962 the Presbyteries of Huntingdon and Northumberland elected members of a taskforce to search for suitable land for the development of a camp and conference center.. An area of land was found in Little Sugar Valley in the Nittany Mountains. Carlisle Presbytery joined in a purchase of service agreement in 1973 This increased the number of campers that could attend Krislund. Krislund is nestled on over 800 acres. Krislund offers faith-based summer camp programs in addition to year round conference and retreat facilities. The mission is for all people to encounter God, build relationships and experience creation. The vision is a world where everyone can have a holistic experience of God.
