

Rev. James Martin served the congregation from 1925 until 1948, and under his pastorate the Vacation Bible School was started. To quote Dr. Robert Banks in his presentation in 1975 "he was a good pastor and his sermons were thought stimulating."

On March 7 1929 a congregational meeting was held to purchase the current manse for \$9500 from A. Parker McMeen; and on April 4, 1929 a meeting was held to sell the manse on Washington Avenue to Mr. Chester McCormick for \$5600. In 1940 there was a fire on the Third Street side of the church but only minor damage was done.

Rev. Paul J. Weatherley occupied the pulpit from 1949 to 1952. The church celebrated its' 75th Anniversary in 1950 and The Women's Association was formed in 1952.

Rev. Elmer Davis served from 1952 until 1959. In 1956 the church school annex was added to provide room for the nursery and primary children. The Synod on July 6 1958 transferred Westminster congregation from Huntingdon Presbytery to Carlisle Presbytery. In July 1954 a tornado occurred. The church spire and bell tower were blown to the ground killing a passerby and injuring another. The tower was rebuilt without the steeple.

Rev. Eugene Stanbaugh was called in 1959 and resigned in 1964 to accept a pastorate in another church. During this time, by direction of the Synod, the congregation voted to amend the title of the church to "Westminster United Presbyterian Church of Mifflintown." In 1965 Rev. Robert W. Yetter was called and served until 1980. During his pastorate the 100th centennial was celebrated July 13, 1975.

Rev. Douglas H. Kelley served from 1981 until 1996. A major renovation and refurbishment to the church and manse was made during 1992 and 1993 costing nearly \$125,000. The Trustees borrowed \$75,000 to undertake the project and from large donations from the Caramel and other projects, plus the support of the congregation the loan was paid off in 1996.

After 1996 the church was served by Rev. William C. Mielke, Interim pastor from 1997 to 1999; and Rev. Louise Reynolds served from summer of 1999 until February 2000.

Rev. David A. Cook was called as pastor in July 2000.
